This event has been co-produced with a group of enthusiastic (and passionate) patients and members of staff from the NHS Leeds Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG) Partnership who have been meeting regularly on the PPG event project group. Introduction – “Setting the Scene” (10:00 – 11:00)

It's important to know what the current status of PPGs in Leeds are and the context to which the PPGs are doing their work. To give us a better idea of this, the speakers will look at where we are and where we are going on a broader scale.

Session 1 – “PPGs: A Hidden Asset” (11:00 – 12:25)

As we probably know, there is a great deal of variation across Leeds in terms of the provision of PPGs. Some are well established and have been running for years, others are just getting started (and maybe not for the first time). Speakers will be looking at expectations of the PPGs and the people who help make it happen (the members and the practice) as well as some of the tools to help make PPGs work. There will also be the opportunity to ask questions during the 'PPG Panel'.

Lunch, Stalls and Networking (12:25 – 1:25)

During the lunch hour we don't want you to just enjoy your food, we want you to chat with other PPG members, share good practice or put ideas forward. There will be nearly 20 stalls that you can visit in the room from a wide variety of different organisations that can all help support the work PPGs do in some way.

Session 2 – Making the PPGs Work: Sharing the Load (1:25 – 2:50)

There is a lot of good work going on throughout the city already and there's plenty that can be done. During this session there will be examples of what is going on in PPGs already as well as the opportunity to think about what work PPGs can be involved with, including some practical examples.

Session 3 – The Leeds PPG Network (2:50 – 3:30)

To round off the day, speakers would like to think about how PPGs can develop and move forward and be better supported. The event project group have been working on developing a proposal for a citywide 'Leeds PPG Network', which aims to help support PPGs to be more effective. Speakers will be proposing the idea of the Network and some particulars, with the opportunity to provide some feedback.
