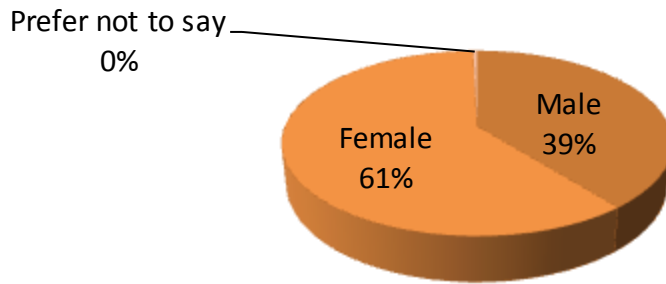
Responses include all survey returns and focus groups but not people who attended the event in Swillington.



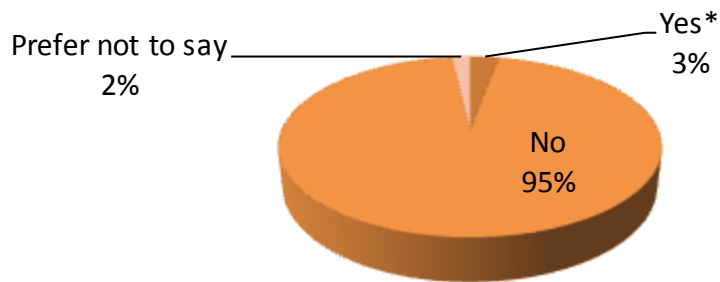


We also received feedback from people who were Slavic, Spanish, Scandinavian, Latvian, Australian and Polish. Some people preferred to see themselves as White English.

Gender

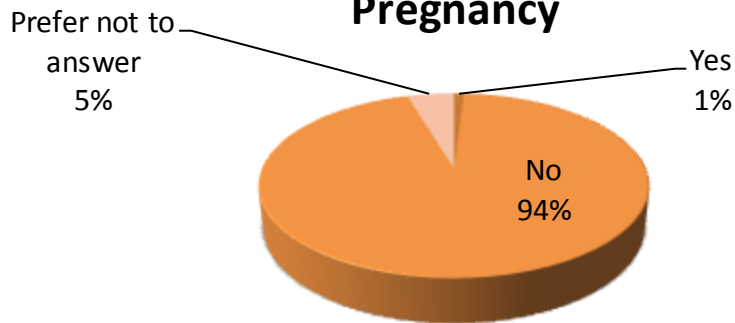


Transgender

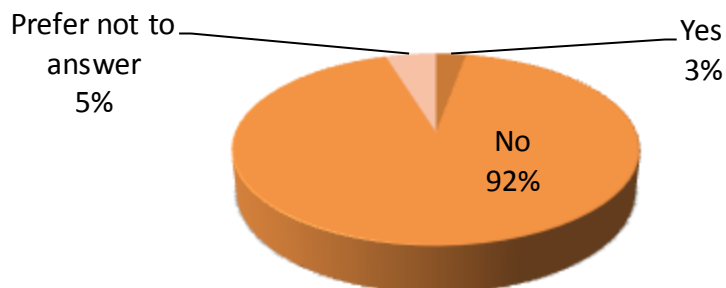


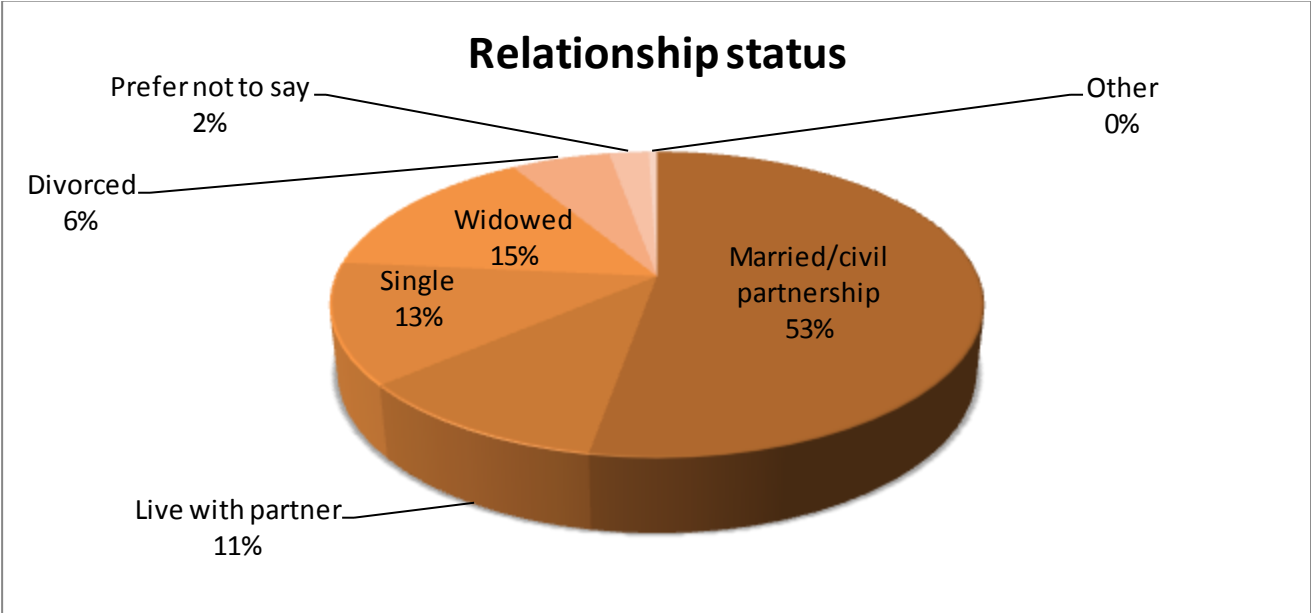
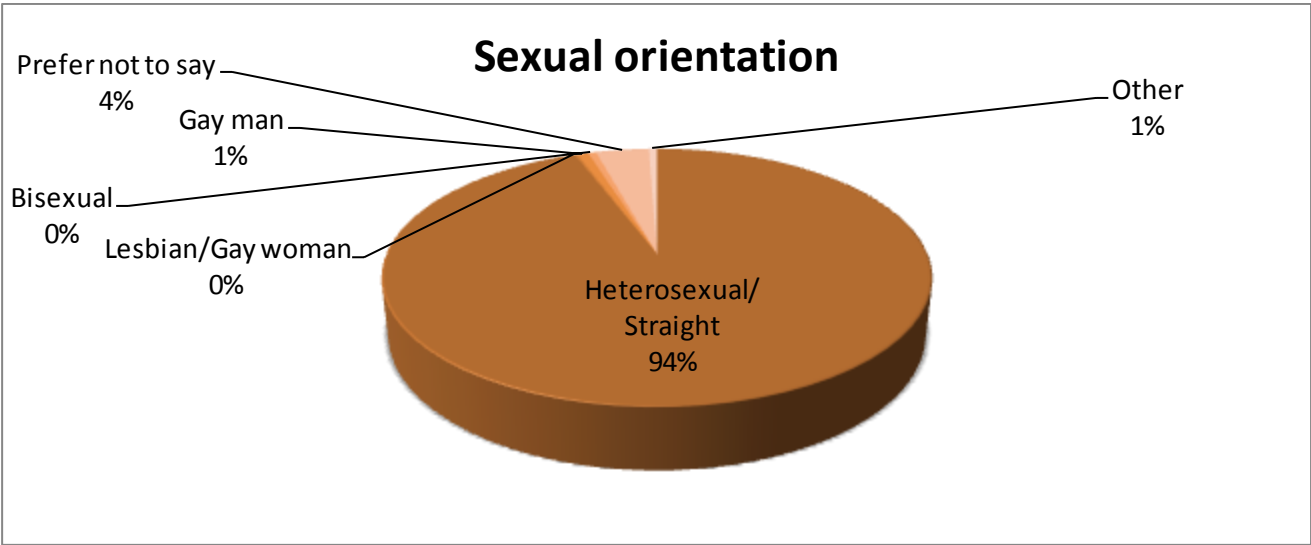
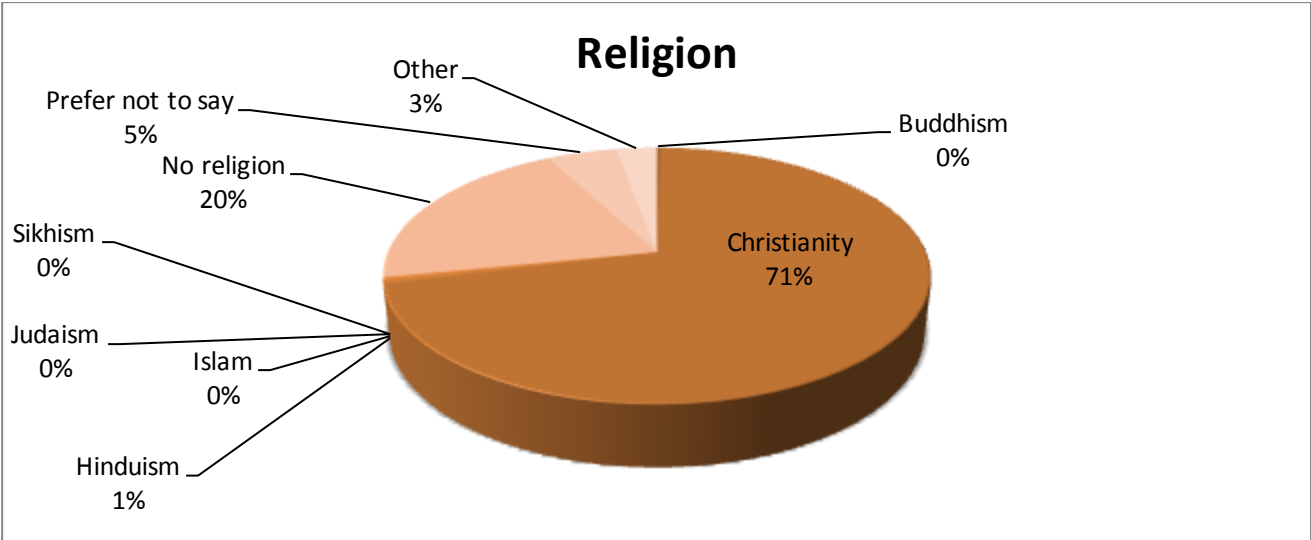
* It is unlikely that such a high percentage of people identify themselves as 'transgender'. This result may be due to a lack of understanding around the question.
