Closure of Radshan Medical Centre

1. What this document is about

The Practice Group have taken the difficult decision to resign from their contract at Radshan Medical Centre after providing services to the population for a number of years.

Over recent times, it has become increasingly difficult to attract GPs to the practice in its current form, with the building itself no longer suitable to deliver modern healthcare services.

Following the resignation of the Practice Group, the practice will close on 30 April 2018 meaning people will need to register with a new GP practice. We want to make sure that you have access to the best GP care available and want to work with you to help you find and register with an alternative GP practice of your choice.

This document outlines how closing this practice will affect you and what you need to do. It is also an opportunity for you to tell us what's important to you and what you want from your GP practice.

2. Background

The Practice Group tendered their resignation to the NHS Leeds South and East Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG) on 31 October 2017. The CCG accepted the resignation and started to look at options for the future of the practice

Unfortunately there are no other GP practices in the local area who wish to take over the practice in its current form or an alternative form and the building itself is not suitable to deliver modern healthcare services. We understand patients with restricted mobility are not able to access the first floor, as there is no a lift. There are also other GP practices within the local area who have confirmed they have the capacity to take additional patients.

3. How will this affect me?

If you are a registered patient at this practice then you will be affected by the closure of the surgery. It's important that you read this document to help you to decide on what the next steps may be for you to access GP services.

4. What do I need to do?

You now need to decide which GP practice you want to register with. There are several GP practices within your area that you may choose to join. All practices in the area have open lists and are able to register new patients. We would encourage you to register with a practice in your local area.
