1. Background

NHS Leeds Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG) organises the delivery of NHS health services for the population of Leeds (around 870,000 people).

Together with a local young leader, the CCG is working to develop a youth charter which aims to:

- Raise the profile of what matters most to young people in Leeds
- Create stronger links between young people, the CCG and our partners from across the city
- Help link young people's priorities with those of the CCG
- Develop and enhance ways for young people's voices to be heard, especially the voices of young people from under-represented sections of our communities

To get us started, we are keen to understand what young people in the city think about living in Leeds and about its current health care system.

What is the health care system?
